frozen by Christmas.

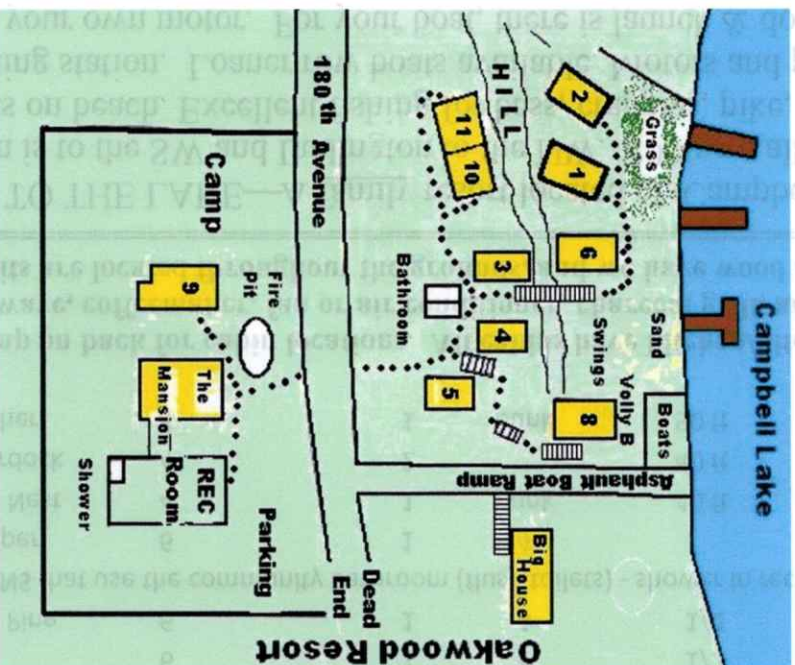
January and February - Snowmobile,
ice fish, cross country ski, snowshoe,
hunting, or just relaxing. Downhill
skiing: Caberfae Peaks 66 miles and
Crystal Mountain 88 miles.

March and April - Fish, hike. Lake
usually thaws by April 1st.

May - Hunt mushrooms, fish, hike.
Lake water begins to warm up for
water sports.

From Hesperia, follow M-20 west
for 2 miles. Turn right (north) on
192nd Ave. Follow 192nd 4
miles to Gale Road. Turn left
(west) on Gale Road and go
1-1/2 miles to 180th Ave. Turn
right (north) and follow 180th
about 3/4 mile to our sign.
