

Memorial Weekend thru Labor Day
Water sports, swim, boat, fish, hike, bike. Michigan free fishing weekend is the 2nd weekend in June-no license required.

September - Water is still warm. Human wildlife returns to school and work - Nature's wildlife increases with peace and quiet. Fish, hike, bike. Trees start to change color. Salmon start in rivers; can last into winter.

October - Beautiful color. Fish lake and rivers, hike, bike.

November - Still some color. Hunt, fish, possibly snow.

December - Hunt, snowmobile, cross country ski, snowshoe. Lake usually frozen by Christmas.

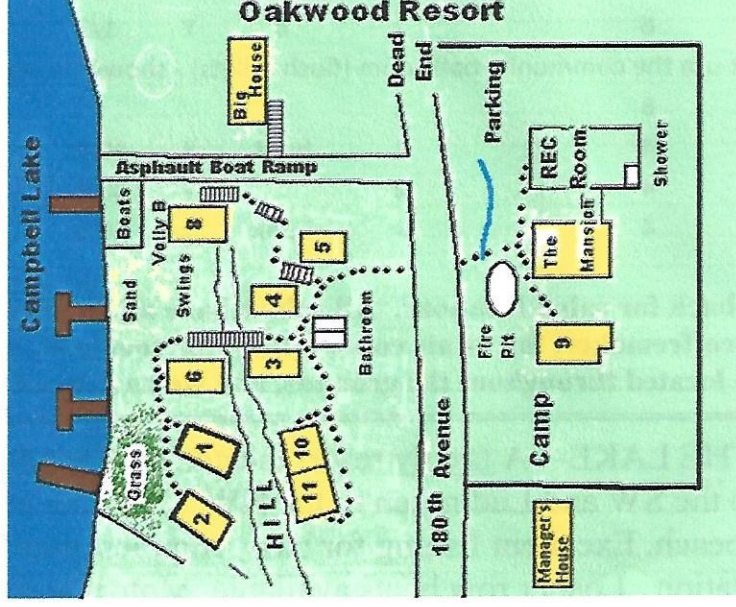
January and February - Snowmobile, ice fish, cross country ski, snowshoe, hunting, or just relaxing. Downhill skiing: Caberfae Peaks 66 miles and Crystal Mountain 88 miles.

March and April - Fish, hike. Lake usually thaws by April 1st.

May - Hunt mushrooms, fish, hike. Lake water begins to warm up for water sports.

Directions:

From Hesperia, follow M-20 west for 2 miles. Turn right (north) on 192nd Ave. Follow 192nd 4 miles to Gale Road. Turn left (west) on Gale Road and go 1-1/2 miles to 180th Ave. Turn right (north) and follow 180th about 3/4 mile to our sign. Please check in with manager.
