

Memorial Weekend thru Labor Day
Water sports, swim, boat, fish, hike, bike. Michigan free fishing weekend is the 2nd weekend in June-no license required.

September - Water is still warm. Human wildlife returns to school and work - Nature's wildlife increases with peace and quiet. Fish, hike, bike. Trees start to change color. Salmon start in rivers; can last into winter.

October - Beautiful color. Fish lake and rivers, hike, bike.

November - Still some color. Hunt, fish, possibly snow.

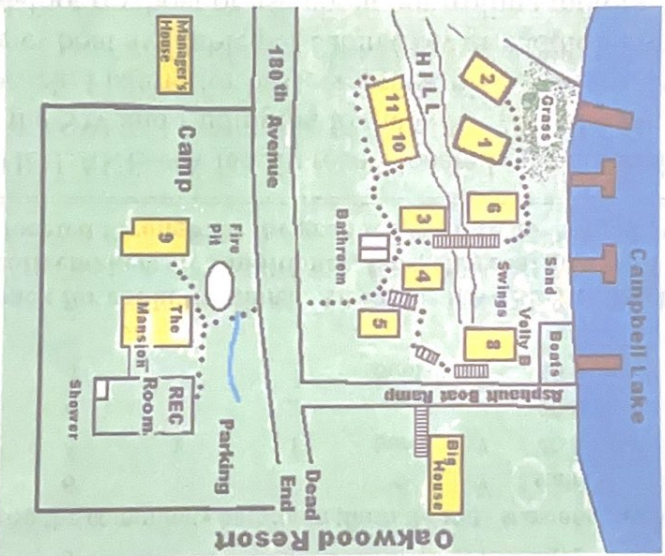
December - Hunt, snowmobile, cross country ski, snowshoe. Lake usually frozen by Christmas.

January and February - Snowmobile, ice fish, cross country ski, snowshoe hunting, or just relaxing. Downhill skiing: Caberfae Peaks 66 miles and Crystal Mountain 88 miles.

March and April - Fish, hike. Lake usually thaws by April 1st.

May - Hunt mushrooms, fish, hike. Lake water begins to warm up for water sports.

Directions:
From Hesperia, follow M-20 west for 2 miles. Turn right (north) on 192nd Ave. Follow 192nd 4 miles to Gale Road. Turn left (west) on Gale Road and go 1-1/2 miles to 180th Ave. Turn right (north) and follow 180th about 3/4 mile to our sign. Please check in with manager.

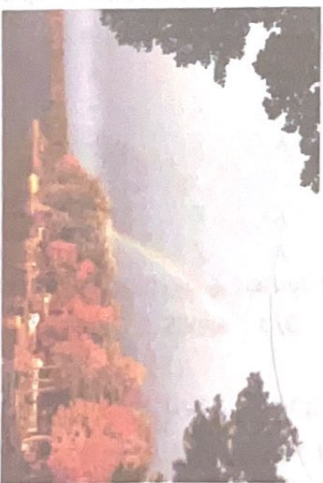

See map on back for cabin locations. All cabins have kitchen/kitchenette with stove, refrigerator, microwave, coffeemaker, air conditioner, fans, charcoal grill, and picnic table.

Fire pits are located throughout the grounds, and we have wood available for purchase.

ESCAPE TO THE LAKE—A family resort located on Campbell Lake near Hesperia, MI. Muskegon is to the SW and Ludington to the NW. 200-acre all sports lake with sandy beach. Swing sets on beach. Fishing for bass, crappies, pike, bluegill, and perch plus fish-cleaning station. One loaner boat available per cabin (row or paddle). For power source, your motor should fit our 14-foot rowboat or ask about our trolling motors. If bringing your boat, we will locate dock space and trailer parking. If bringing more than 1 boat per cabin, alert us to see if space is available. For those bad weather days, we have an enclosed recreation room with eating area, ping pong, pool table, board games, etc. Outside volleyball, horseshoes, shuffleboard. The cabins are located 1 hour northwest of Grand Rapids in Manistee National Forest. Thousands of acres of public land nearby with hiking and biking trails. **Pets with special permission only. Management must be notified if you are having visitors.** There may be no room for them or their vehicles. Day visitors (anyone staying more than 1 hour) \$5 person. Night visitors (anyone staying past 11 pm) \$10. **This is a family resort with quiet hours 11pm-7am. We do have neighbors as well as cabins that are in close proximity to each other. Only a moderate use of alcohol will be tolerated. If you plan to drink excessively, make your plans elsewhere.**
